Medical Brand Strategy:

- Develop and build relationships with Key External Experts (KEEs) and emerging KEEs through one-to-one meetings and attendance at relevant meetings, congresses and symposia.
- Drive insight gathering activities across medical affairs team. Responsible for the collation and dissemination of brand-related insights to relevant personnel across the LEO Pharma organization.
- Devise Medical Strategy for Thrombosis, aligned with both the overall UKIE Thrombosis Strategy and the Global Thrombosis Medical Strategy. Develop specific tactics to achieve Critical Success Factors (CSFs) and ensure delivery of these tactics within agreed timelines and costs.

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- Monitor and review UKIE Medical Affairs costs on an ongoing basis to ensure alignment with budget.
- Ensure relevant insights, competitor information or clinical/medical/scientific insights or issues are reported to the Global Medical Director, Thrombosis and the Business Unit Director, Thrombosis.
- Supervise the submission, review, approval and follow-up of Investigator Initiated Study (IIS) proposals.

Input into Cross-functional Brand Strategy

- Maintain up to date clinical knowledge in appropriate therapeutic areas and provide strategic and operational input into cross-functional brand objectives. Provide scientific/medical information, advice and insight to internal colleagues as required.
- Maintain up to date knowledge and insight on competitor data, publications and activities to inform LEO Pharma XFT.
- Work with cross-function teams and global/regional teams to help produce materials and activities as agreed.
- Attend appropriate UKIE and corporate cross-functional meetings, providing relevant country-level medical/scientific insight and information as required and representing the UKIE Thrombosis team.
- Align with cross-functional brand team to agree the plan for management of KEEs and emerging KEEs. Communicate and drive plan with the global medical team and local Business Unit Director, Thrombosis.
- Develop and maintain good working relationships with appropriate corporate and UKIE personnel.
- Provide medical/scientific support to training team, and provide therapy area/product training as required.

ABPI/IPHA Codes and Medical Information

- Provide efficient and effective ABPI/IPHA medical review (and approval if a signatory) to help optimize the achievement of business goals. Prioritise relevant items, and maintain good communication with originators and other reviewers to agree priorities and timescales.
- Provide advice on ABPI/IPHA-related issues and escalate complex challenges and identified deviations/risks to the Signatory Alignment Meeting and/or Compliance Review Committee (CRC) as required.
- Investigate and respond to ABPI/IPHA complaints regarding LEO Pharma activities and/or materials if required. Devise appeals to rulings if appropriate.
- Attend Weekly Signatory Alignment Meeting routinely and CRC if required to provide expert insight.
- Keep up to date with Code rulings and advice.
- Respond, within agreed timelines, to escalated Medical Information enquiries when requested.

Professional Competencies:

- Scientific Qualification to at least degree level.
- Pharmaceutical Industry Experience, some of which in a Medical Affairs role (including MSL).
- Background in haematology/thrombosis is desirable.
- ABPI/IPHA signatory experience is desirable.
